VACCINATION GUIDELINES & LABEL DIRECTIONS

ADJUVANT: SuprImm®

DIRECTIONS: Shake well before using. Administer 2 mL subcutaneously. In accordance with Beef Quality Assurance guidelines, this product should be administered subcutaneously (under the skin) in the neck. For foot rot, revaccinate in 3 weeks. For liver abscesses, revaccinate in 60 days. Revaccinate annually or anytime endemic conditions exist, exposure is imminent, or as recommended by your veterinarian.

PRECAUTIONS: Store out of direct sunlight at 2°–7°C (35°–45°F). DO NOT FREEZE. Use entire contents when first opened. Do not vaccinate within 21 days prior to slaughter. Anaphylactic reactions may occur. Symptomatic treatment: Epinephrine.
